Travelling to The Big Tent By foot, bike, train, bus or car, there are plenty ways of getting to Big Tent! Big Tent is held on Falkland Estate which is only 35 miles north of Edinburgh and 23 miles south of Dundee. Local train stations at Ladybank and Markinch are a few miles away and we will be providing free connection buses from both there and other locations. If you are coming by car, follow the AA signs avoiding the village of Falkland and be ready with £5 for your festival parking.
