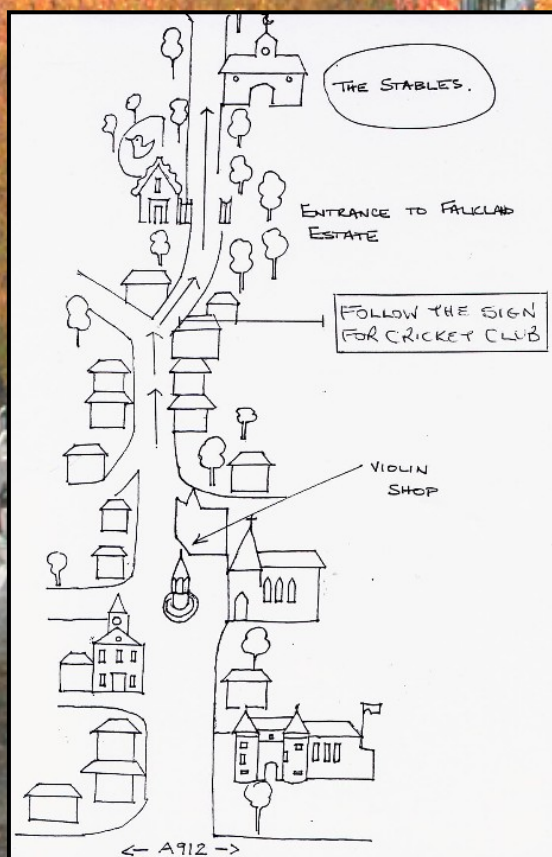

From the A912 after turning into Falkland's main street (passing the Palace on your right), continue past the fountain, and keep straight ahead into the street called Westport (passing the Violin Shop on the right). At the end of the village, turn right (following the sign for the Cricket Club). Continue on through the Estate gates and past the Lodge on the left. The car park is on your right. The Stables is the first building on the right on the Estate road. The Workshop is at the rear of the stable block: go past the car park, take a right turn.
