Zero Waste Coordinator (part-time, job share) Until 31 March 2012 JOB DESCRIPTION

Falkland Centre for Stewardship has been awarded funding by Zero Waste Scotland to deliver a Zero Waste Project across Fife until 31 March 2011. The Zero Waste Volunteer Programme seeks to reduce waste and to prevent waste. Here in Fife we are working with four main strands: Love Food, Hate Waste, home composting, stop the drop and recycle now. Our project involves recruiting volunteers, training them up and passing the messages on to Fifers.

In addition, Falkland Centre for Stewardship has become the training centre for the Zero Waste Volunteer Programme to learn more about the Love Food, Hate Waste campaign. Working with chefs, we will be providing hands on cooking demonstrations and workshops to Zero Waste Coordinators and their volunteers throughout Scotland. This is currently in its pilot phase and it will be a key task of this post to develop training material and facilitate this project.

Key tasks:

- Responsible for a creative, ambitious, dynamic, Fife wide recruitment drive for volunteers, creating a buzz and excitement around the Zero Waste messages and demonstrating clear ways to volunteer.
- PR, publicity and advertising
- Website maintenance and development
- Database development and upkeep
- Newsletters to volunteers and supporters
- · Identifying events and other opportunities for volunteers to attend
- Attending events where appropriate
- Facebook, twitter and other social media
- Ensuring photographic and other recording of events and activities for future promotional use by both Falkland Centre for Stewardship and Zero Waste Scotland.
- Developing additional resources for use
- Identifying suitable games and activities for volunteers to use at events
- Populating the Volunteer base at Falkland Centre for Stewardship with appropriate resources.
- Attending any training coordinator events deemed appropriate by Zero Waste Scotland.
- Training volunteers interested in the above activities eg facebook, twitter.
- Project management of the Love Food, Hate Waste training centre including liaison with chefs, developing and refining training materials, organising the venue, ensuring compliance with health and safety regulations.

Remuneration:

This position is offered at a rate of £16 per hour. There are 488 hours within the contract. 160 of these hours are to be worked during Sept-Dec (or Oct-Dec depending on start date) for project management of the Love Food, Hate Waste training centre. The remaining 328 hours are to be worked evenly from start date to 31 March. The total award is therefore £7808. This is a salaried position and the Zero Waste Coordinator will receive 10, (7 hour) paid days holidays (this includes public holidays). Salaries will be paid at the end of each month, in arrears by BACS subject to the production of satisfactory timesheets.
